The Theme of Composition:

- The composition should be uplifting and positive.
- It should be a piece that will inspire and encourage the nation as we continue our efforts together to contain the virus.
- The composition should reflect all society as we dedicate it to our communities, from our healthcare workers, to cocooning elderly, from government officials to parents and students.

The Prize:

- A recording session in MIC Studios, Moneygall, Co.Tipperary, to record the winning composition.
- The winning composition will be released on iTunes & Apple music with all funds raised

going towards a charity connected to the Covid-19 pandemic.

Terms and conditions:

- You must be a current student of St Mary's Holy Faith Glasnevin.
- Your composition must be all your own work.
- The piece must be brand new, composed between 9th April and 6th May 2020.
- No group submissions allowed it must be composed and performed by one student.
- Only one submission per student.
- The duration of the piece must not exceed 4 mins.
- Parental permission for under 18s will be sought with every recording submitted.
- There is one external judge, Ian Callanan, Composer, Arranger and Producer.
- Submissions must be received by Wednesday 6th May 2020.
